Please see your plan materials for specific details about how these products and medications may be covered under your pharmacy benefit.

For the primary prevention of cardiovascular disease and colorectal cancer in adults > 50 years old.

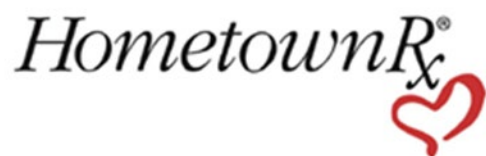
For prevention of dental cavities in infants & children < 6 years old.

Folic Acid

For prevention of birth defects in females < 55 years old who are planning to become or are able to become pregnant.

Folic Acid Tablet 0.4mg, 1mg	Folic Acid Capsule or Tablet 0.8mg
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HIV PrEP

For persons who are at high risk acquisition (PA required).

Truvada 200-300mg	Emtricitabine-Tenofovir Disoproxil Fumarate 200-300mg

For the primary prevention of cardiovascular disease in adults age 40 to 75 years old with no history of cardiovascular disease who are at an increased risk.
